THE GOLDEN RULE



1. ADMONISH one another

<u>Colossians 3:16</u> "Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and **ADMONISHING one another** in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God."

2. (Be) AFFECTIONATE to one another

<u>Romans 12:10</u> "As for brotherly love, be <u>AFFECTIONATE</u> to one another; in matters of worldly honor, yield to one another."

3. <u>AGREE</u> with one another - Be of one mind with one another

<u>I Corinthians 1:10</u> "I appeal to you, brothers, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you AGREE with one another so that there may be no divisions among you and that you may be perfectly united in mind and thought."

<u>2 Corinthians 13:11</u> "Finally, brothers, rejoice. Aim for restoration, comfort one another, <u>AGREE</u> with one another, live in peace; and the God of love and peace will be with you."

4. **BEAR WITH** one another

Ephesians 4:1 "As a prisoner for the Lord, then, I urge you to live a life worthy of the calling you have received. Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, **BEARING** with one another in love."

5. BUILD one another UP!!!!!

<u>1 Thessalonians 5:11</u> "Therefore encourage one another and <u>BUILD ONE</u> <u>another up</u>, just as you are doing."



<u>Romans 14:19</u> "So let us then definitely aim for and eagerly pursue what makes for harmony and **for mutual <u>BUILDING UP</u>** (edification and development) of one another."

6. CARE for one another

<u>1 Corinthians 12:25</u> "that there should be no schism in the body, but that the members should have the same <u>CARE</u> for one another."

7. CARRY one another's burdens

<u>Galatians 6:1-2</u> "Brethren, if a man is overtaken in any trespass, you who are spiritual restore such a one in a spirit of gentleness, considering yourself lest you also be tempted. <u>CARRY</u> one another's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ."

8. COMFORT one another

2 Corinthians 13:11 "Finally, brothers, rejoice. Aim for restoration, **COMFORT one another**, agree with one another, live in peace; and the God of love and peace will be with you."

<u>2 Corinthians 1:4</u> "God comforts us in all our troubles so **that we can** <u>COMFORT OTHERS.</u> When they are troubled, we will be able to give them the same comfort God has given us."

I Thessalonians 4:18 "Therefore, COMFORT one another with these words."

9. Have COMPASSION for one another

<u>I Peter 3:8</u> "Finally, all of you be of one mind, having <u>COMPASSION</u> for one another; love as brothers, be tenderhearted, be courteous."



10. CONFESS your sins to one another

<u>James 5:15</u> "Therefore, <u>CONFESS</u> your sins to one another, and pray for one another so that you may be healed. The effective prayer of a righteous man can accomplish much."

11. <u>CONSIDER</u> one another - the idea is to consider with a purpose

<u>Hebrews 10:24</u> "And let us CONSIDER one another in order to stir up love and good deeds."

12. (Be) CONSIDERATE of one another

<u>1 Corinthians 1:10</u> (Message) "I have a serious concern to bring up with you, my friends, using the authority of Jesus, our Master. I'll put it as urgently as I can: You must get along with each other. You must learn to be <u>CONSIDERATE</u> of one another, cultivating a life in common.

<u>1 Corinthians 10:33</u> "I try my best to be <u>CONSIDERATE</u> of everyone's feelings in all these matters; I hope you will be, too."

13. Be <u>COURTEOUS</u> to one another

<u>I Peter 3:8</u> "Finally, all of you be of one mind, having compassion for one another; love as brothers, be tenderhearted, be <u>COURTEOUS</u> to one another."

14. Be DEVOTED to one another

Romans 12:10 "Be **DEVOTED** to one another in brotherly love. Honor one another above yourselves."



15. EDIFY one another

Romans 14:19 "Therefore, let us pursue the things which make for peace and the things by which one may **EDIFY one another.**"

16. ENCOURAGE one another

<u>1 Thessalonians 5:11</u> "Therefore <u>ENCOURAGE</u> one another and build each other up, just as in fact you are doing."

<u>1 Thessalonians 5:14</u> "Now we exhort you, brethren, warn those who are unruly, <u>ENCOURAGE</u> THE FAINTHEARTED, uphold the weak, be patient with all."

17. <u>ESTEEM</u> one another better than self (a one-word mission statement – OTHERS)

Philippians 2:3 "Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each ESTEEM others better than himself. 4 Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others. 5 Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus,"

18. EXHORT one another

<u>Hebrews 3:13</u> "But <u>EXHORT</u> one another daily, while it is called "Today," lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin."

19. FELLOWSHIP with one another

1 John 1:7"But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have FELLOWSHIP with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin."



20. FORGIVE one another

Ephesians 4:32 "Be kind and compassionate to one another, **FORGIVING** each other, just as in Christ God forgave you."

21. Be GENTLE with one another

<u>Colossians 3:12-13</u> "As saints of God, then, holy and dearly loved, **let your behavior be marked** by pity and mercy, kind feelings, a low opinion of yourselves, <u>gentle ways</u>, and a power of undergoing all things;

13 Being <u>GENTLE</u> to one another and having forgiveness for one another, if anyone has done wrong to his brother, even as the Lord had forgiveness for you:

22. DO GOOD to one another

<u>Galatians 6:10</u> "Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us <u>DO GOOD</u> to all (to one another), especially to those who are of the household of faith."

23. (Be) GRACIOUS, especially with your words

<u>Colossians 4:6</u> "Let your speech always be with <u>GRACE</u>, seasoned with salt, that you may know how you ought to answer each one."

<u>Luke 4:22</u> "So all bore witness to Jesus, and marveled at the <u>GRACIOUS</u> words which proceeded out of His mouth."

24. Live in HARMONY with one another

<u>Romans 12:16</u> "Live in <u>HARMONY</u> with one another. Do not be proud, but be willing to associate with people of low position. Do not be conceited."



25. HONOR one another

Romans 12:10 "Be devoted to one another in brotherly love. **HONOR** one another above yourselves."

ESV, <u>Romans 12:10</u> "Love one another with brotherly affection. **Outdo one** another in showing HONOR."

26. (Be) HOSPITABLE to one another

I Peter 4:9 "Offer HOSPITALITY to one another without grumbling."

27. (Be) HUMBLE with one another

Ephesians 4:1 "As a prisoner for the Lord, then, I urge you to live a life worthy of the calling you have received. Be completely HUMBLE and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love."

28. INSTRUCT one another

Romans 15:14 "I myself am convinced, my brothers, that you yourselves are full of goodness, complete in knowledge and competent to **INSTRUCT** one another."

29. (Be) KIND to one another

Ephesians 4:32 "Be KIND and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you."

30. (Be) LONGSUFFERING with one another

Ephesians 4:2 "with all lowliness and gentleness, with **LONGSUFFERING**, bearing with one another in love,"



31. LOOK OUT for the INTEREST of Others

<u>Philippians 2:3-4</u> Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself. **4** Let each of you **LOOK OUT** not only for his own interests, but also **(LOOK OUT)** for the **INTEREST of OTHERS**.

32. LOVE one another!!!!!!!

John 13:34-35 "A new command I give you that you LOVE one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another. By this all men will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another."

<u>1 Thessalonians 4:9</u> But concerning brotherly <u>LOVE</u> you have no need that I should write to you, for you yourselves are taught by God to <u>LOVE</u> one <u>another</u>:

<u>1 Peter 1:22</u> "Now that you have purified yourselves by obeying the truth so that you have sincere love for your brothers, <u>LOVE</u> one another deeply, from the heart."

<u>1 John 4:7</u> "Dear friends, let us <u>LOVE</u> one another, for love comes from God. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God."

<u>I Thessalonians 3:12</u> "And may the Lord make you increase and abound in <u>LOVE</u> to one another and to all, just as we *do* to you.

33. (Be) MERCIFUL to one another

<u>Luke 6:36</u> "Therefore be <u>MERCIFUL</u>, just as your Father also is merciful."

34. MINISTER to one another using your spiritual gift to build others up in the faith.

1 Peter 4:10 "As each of you have received a gift, (your spiritual gift)



MINISTER IT to one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God."

35. (Be) PATIENT with one another

<u>1 Thessalonians 5:14</u> Now we exhort you, brethren, warn those who are unruly, comfort the fainthearted, uphold the weak, be <u>PATIENT</u> with all (with one another.

Ephesians 4:2 Be completely humble and gentle; be **PATIENT**, bearing with one another in love.

36. (Be at) PEACE with one another

2 Corinthians 13:11 Finally, brothers, rejoice. Aim for restoration, comfort one another, agree with one another, and **live in PEACE**; and the God of love and peace will be with you.

<u>I Thessalonians 5:13</u> Live in <u>PEACE</u> with one another.

Romans 14:19 "Therefore let us pursue the things which make for **PEACE** and the things by which one may edify another.

Romans 12:18 "If possible, so far as it depends on you, live peaceably with all."

37. PRAY for one another!

James 5:16 "And PRAY one for another."

38. PREFERRING one another

Rom. 12:10 "Be affectionate to your brethren and love one another; be **PREFERRING** and honoring one another."



39. RECEIVE one another

Romans 15:7 "Welcome and **RECEIVE** to your hearts one another, then, even as Christ has welcomed and received you, for the glory of God."

40. REFRESH one another

<u>1 Cor. 16:18</u> "For they <u>REFRESHED</u> my spirit and yours as well. Show your appreciation, therefore, to such men."

41. RESPECT one another

<u>I Peter 2:17</u> "Show proper <u>RESPECT</u> to everyone:" Recall from <u>I Corinthians</u> <u>13:5</u> that love does not behave rudely.

42. RESTORE one another

Galatians 6:1-2 "Brethren, if a man is overtaken in any trespass, you who are spiritual **RESTORE** such a one in a spirit of gentleness, considering yourself lest you also be tempted. Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ."

<u>2 Corinthians 13:11</u> "Finally, brothers, rejoice. Aim for <u>RESTORATION</u>, comfort one another, agree with one another, live in peace (with one another), and the God of love and peace will be with you.

43. SERVE one another

<u>Galatians 5:13</u> "You, my brothers, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the sinful nature; rather, <u>SERVE</u> one another in love."

44. STRENGTHEN one another

Hebrews 12:12 Therefore, **STRENGTHEN** the hands which hang down, and the feeble knees,



45. SUBMIT to one another

Ephesians 5:21 "SUBMIT to one another out of reverence for Christ."

46. <u>SUPPORT</u> ONE ANOTHER as they experience good and bad.

Romans 12:15 (SUPPORT one another by) "Rejoicing with those who rejoice and weeping with those who weep"

47. TEACH one another

<u>Colossians 3:16</u> "Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly as you <u>TEACH</u> and admonish **one another** with all wisdom, and as you sing psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs with gratitude in your hearts to God."

48. Be TENDERHEARTED toward one another

Ephesians. 4:32 "And be kind to one another, **TENDERHEARTED**, forgiving one another, just as God in Christ forgave you."

49. (Be) THANKFUL for one another

Philippians 1:3 "Every time I think of you, I give THANKS to my God."

50. <u>UNDERSTANDING</u> – dwell with one another with understanding

<u>1 Peter 3:7</u> "Husbands, likewise, dwell with them with <u>UNDERSTANDING</u>, giving honor to the wife, as to the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life, that your prayers may not be hindered."



51. (Be of) UNITY OF MIND

<u>1 Peter 3:8</u> "Finally, all of you, have UNITY of mind with one another, sympathy, brotherly love, a tender heart, and a humble mind."

52. <u>UPHOLD</u> one another - uphold the weak

<u>1 Thessalonians 5:14</u> Now we exhort you, brethren, warn those who are unruly, encourage the fainthearted, <u>UPHOLD</u> the WEAK, be patient with all.

53. WARN one another - warn the unruly

<u>1 Thessalonians 5:14</u> Now we exhort you, brethren, <u>WARN</u> THOSE WHO ARE **UNRULY**, encourage the fainthearted, uphold the weak, be patient with all.

54. WASH one another's feet

<u>John 13:14</u> "If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to <u>WASH</u> one another's feet."

55. WELCOME one another

<u>Romans 15:7</u> <u>"WELCOME</u> and receive to your hearts one another, then, even as Christ has welcomed and received you, for the glory of God."

56. YIELD to one another

Rom. 12:10 "As for brotherly love, be affectionate to one another; in matters of worldly honor, **YIELD** to one another."

Matthew 7:12 NASB "In everything, therefore, treat people the same way you want them to treat you, for this is the Law and the Prophets."
